Welcome To Worship

Welcome to Good Samaritan's worship service, we are so glad you came today. We are a new church start sponsored by Killearn United Methodist Church. Please get a nametag, grab a cup of coffee & a donut and make yourself at home.

We have a nursery for children from 4 weeks through Kindergarten. We invite school-aged children to worship with us in the service. There are Kids' Worship Bags and Children's Bulletins available to help keep hands occupied and minds stimulated during worship. We believe that the presence of children in worship enhances our communal worship experience and adds a blessing to the life of the church family. If you wish children can attend Kids' Worship at the dismissal time during the service. You may retrieve your children in the chorus room during communion or following the worship service.

Holy Communion is celebrated each time we gather together on Sunday. We have an open communion table. Everyone who desires to be forgiven for their sin and to turn to follow Jesus is welcome to come to receive the sacrament. Take the bread that is offered and dip it into the cup.

We believe that the ancient traditions of the Church have much to offer us today when understood. Here are some words they may be unfamiliar along with their definition.

Sacrament: A visible sign of an invisible truth. Holy Communion and Baptism are our sacraments.

Doxology: A short hymn or verse of praise. From the Greek Doxa/glorify and Logos/word

Acolytes: These are the children who symbolically bring in the light of Christ by lighting the candles on the altar signifying the beginning of our worship service and Christ's presence among us.
